


HOW TO USE GOOGLE EARTH


<p>1. Open Google Earth</p>	<p>2. Make sure that you have "Borders & Labels, Places, and Photos" marked.</p>		<p>3. In the search box, type in the state or country you want to explore. Click the search button.</p>	
<p>4. Use the + or - sign to get closer or further away.</p>		<p>5. Once you have picked a location that you like, make sure you have highlighted "My Places" and create a new folder.</p>		
<p>6. Place a pin in the location by clicking on the "pin button" in the toolbar.</p>		<p>7. Name your pin. If you want, you can click on the pin and move it, and you can also change it's design.</p>	 <p>"hint" more icons at the end of the label bar.</p>	<p>8. Search for your next location, repeat steps 4-7 for each one.</p>

9. If you need to edit or change your pin, right click on it and click "get info" or "properties"



10. When you have all your pins in place, click on your tour title.



11. Then click on the folder in the corner that has a tiny triangle.



12. When viewing your Google Earth Tour, you can pause the tour and view images, and discuss information and facts. Then continue the tour when you are ready.
